

The 10th Annual Sewickley Valley Antiques Show

1. What is the Sewickley Valley Antiques Show?

The Sewickley Valley Antiques Show presented by the Child Health Association of Sewickley, is one of the premier antique shows in the region. The show is also one of the major fundraisers for the Child Health Association. The great success of past antique shows has contributed greatly to the ability of Child Health to fund child related programs and services throughout Western Pennsylvania.

2. Where is the event?

The Antique Show and Preview Party will be held at the Edgeworth Club, 511 East Drive, Sewickley, PA 15143. 412-741-8500. See directions at end.

3. What are the dates and time of the event?

Friday, October 16th – Preview Party at the Edgeworth Club 7:00pm – 12:00am
Saturday, October 17th - 10:00a – 5:00p
Sunday, October 18th – 10:00a – 4:00p

4. What is the price of tickets for the Preview Party?

Tickets for the Preview Party are \$65.00.

5. What is the price of tickets for the Show?

Tickets for the show itself are \$10.00 and are valid both days.

6. Where can I purchase tickets?

Preview Party tickets should be reserved by October 6th by calling 412-741-2593 or you can e-mail your Preview Party ticket request to childhealth@comcast.net.

Show tickets can be purchased at the door on the day of the event.

7. Will parking be available?

Parking is available at the Edgeworth Club and on the streets around the club. Parking is also available in the Sewickley Academy parking lot and the Presbyterian Church parking lot.

8. Will refreshments be available at the show?

The Edgeworth Club dining facilities will be open. The Club accepts cash or check – no credit cards.

9. How many antique exhibitors will be participating and what types of antiques will be offered?

This year there will be 26 highly respected and recognized exhibitors from eight states. They will offer an eclectic mix of 18th and 19th Century furniture, porcelain, paintings, jewelry, silver and more.

Directions to Edgeworth Club

From the Airport

Take route 60 Northbound to the Moon/Flaugherty Exit (#8); then take the Moon Business District Exit. Continue straight to the third traffic light. At that light, make a left on to University Boulevard.

Continue through 5 traffic lights and past several car dealerships. At the sixth traffic light, make a left onto the Sewickley Bridge (3-5 miles).

After crossing the bridge, go straight through the intersection into Sewickley (Broad Street). At the 2nd traffic light make a left onto Beaver Street. Continue to the next traffic light which is Academy Avenue. Turn right and go a half a block then turn left onto East Drive. The entrance and parking lot will be on your left past the tennis courts.

South of Sewickley (Washington, Bridgeville, Carnegie, etc.)

Take I-79 North to the Sewickley-Emsworth Exit--bear to the right to go to Sewickley via Route 65 West. Continue on Route 65 until the third traffic light and turn right onto Broad Street. At the 2nd traffic light make a left onto Beaver Street. Continue to the next traffic light which is Academy Avenue. Turn right and go a half a block then turn left onto East Drive. The entrance and parking lot will be on your left past the tennis courts.

North of Sewickley (Cranberry, Wexford, etc.)

Take I-79 South to the Sewickley-Emsworth Exit. From the exit turn left to travel thru Glenfield. Note the speed limit is 25 miles per hour here and is enforced. At the very end of the road turn to the right to go to Sewickley via Route 65 West. Continue on Route 65 until the third traffic light and turn right onto Broad Street. At the 2nd traffic light make a left onto Beaver Street. Continue to the next traffic light which is Academy Avenue. Turn right and go a half a block then turn left onto East Drive. The entrance and parking lot will be on your left past the tennis courts.

From Downtown Pittsburgh

Take 279 North to the Camp Horne Road Exit. At the traffic light, turn to the left onto Camp Horne Road. Follow the road until the end, which is Route 65. Note the speed limit is 35 miles per hour, changes from 35 to 25, then changes back to 35. The limit is strictly enforced. At the very end of the road turn to the right to go to Sewickley via Route 65 West. Continue on Route 65 until the fifth traffic light and turn right onto Broad Street. At the 2nd traffic light make a left onto Beaver Street. Continue to the next traffic light which is Academy Avenue. Turn right and go a half a block then turn left onto East Drive. The entrance and parking lot will be on your left past the tennis courts.
